Terms and Conditions:

Children who cannot swim and children under 8 years of age must be closely supervised at all times by an adult aged 18 or above. Children under supervision are allowed to the depth the adult can stand but no deeper, even if they are using armbands or other buoyancy aid. It is recommended that an adult should supervise no more than two children under 8.

Children aged 8 to 16 may use the Pool unaccompanied provided that they can swim 2 lengths nonstop competently. Anybody unable to swim 2 lengths nonstop must not go out of their depth. Safety advice given by a lifeguard or the Pool manager, and the Pool rules and regulations, must be obeyed.

Family season tickets are for parents/partners and their children 16 and under (including foster children) living at the same address. Grandparents, cousins, foreign students, carers and child minders do not qualify.

Children under 2 years are free, but please include them on the application above. Single tickets are not available to children under 8 – they must be included on a family ticket that has at least one adult family member. Tickets are not transferable and are available for use only by the named person/family.

For safety reasons it may be necessary to control admissions to the Pool during busy periods, including season ticket holders.
