



CAFÉ LIDO



“Run by the community for the community”

Café Lido is a vibrant community café and is part of the Portishead Pool Community Trust (PPCT). The trust was formed in 2008 to save the open air pool from closure and has operated the pool successfully since its reopening in 2009. In 2016 the Trustees awarded tenancy of the café to a group of pool volunteers and Café Lido Ltd was formed as a subsidiary to the PPCT. The café was initially run solely by volunteers and soon outgrew its volunteer capacity so a Manager and a small number of students are employed to supplement the volunteer staff.

Our ethos is to be a community café and work with community groups and welcome them into the café for various events – e.g. our Arts and Crafts Fair, church breakfasts and Gordano Breakfast Rotary Club social events to name but a few. We also pride ourselves on using local suppliers as far as possible to ensure quality, freshness and variety in our menus.

We are seeking an enthusiastic and dynamic chef / assistant manager to oversee the running of the kitchen and the delivery of the café menu.

Job description: Chef/Assistant Manager

Responsible to: Café Manager

Purpose of Job: To oversee the running of the kitchen and the preparation of food in order to deliver the café menu to a consistently high standard. To deputise for the Manager in her absence.

Hours and remuneration: 40 per week April to September, 15 hours per week October to March To include weekends and Bank Holidays

Responsibilities:

- to oversee the day to day efficient running of the kitchen
- to deliver the café menu to a consistently high standard
- to ensure the kitchen is fully compliant in its operations with respect to Health & Safety, Food Hygiene Regulations and Licensing Laws, including maintaining the kitchen records
- to work with the Manager to develop menus
- to oversee front of house in the Manager's absence
- to undertake further training as required
- to attend meetings as required
